The La Plata's Mails.

The Royal Mail steamer La Plata arrived at Montevideo at five o'clock on Monday evening. Her mails came up yesterday in the Villa del Salto.

LATEST FROM LISBON.

Lisbon, June 13th, evening. Public attention in France is centered on the coming elections, as the result will decide the fate of the country for the next ten years.

The Legationists are confident that the Count de Chambord will be made King: the Republicans are very disheartened. The Napoleon partisans are exceedingly active, preparing for the struggle.

The President of the Assembly yesterday read a note from Prince de Joinville, announcing that he accepts his seat for Haut Marne, and resigns that of La Manche.

Thiers, in gratitude to the army, proposes a grand parade to be held on Sunday, June 18th, in front of the Military school.

Duc de Chartres arrived at Versailles on the 11th. Duc d'Annamale has returned to England. No more Courts-martial in Paris.

Arrests at Paris continue, including the painter Courbet and the ex-delegate Rossell. The Italian Government has notified all other powers that the capital will be removed to Rome on January 1st 1872.

Emperor of Russia and Prince Gortchakoff reached Berlin on June 8th, en route for Wildbad. Waldersee is appointed new German Minister to France.

Fears of trouble at La Villette; guards doubled; several arrests. 50,000 men sent to Lyons, and 50,000 to Versailles. Business improving. London, rate of interest 2 1/2. Consols 9 1/2.

ARRIVAL OF H. M. DOM PEDRO IN EUROPE.

Lisbon, June 12th. At 5 o'clock this morning the R.M.S. Douro was in sight, having on board the Emperor and Empress of Brazil.

At 6 o'clock she cast anchor off Belém Tower, where the Corvette Stephanie was in waiting to receive their Majesties and serve as a lazaretto for the usual term.

The Portuguese always find a happy welcome in Brazil, and the community of language, blood and sympathies unites the two nations closely.

LATEST TELEGRAMS.

Paris, June 7. The trial of the insurgents at Versailles commences with Assi. Many arrests are still being made in Paris.

The Patrie of this evening says that before the 5th of July France will have 800,000 breech-loading rifles, without counting those in the course of manufacture.

The proposed fortresses in the interior of Paris will probably be erected on Montmartre and the Buttes Chaumont.

M. Mirès, the banker, died last night at the country residence of his son-in-law, the Comte Rozan, near St. Louis.

FOREIGN.

Forener, June 7th. The Italic announces that General Divesch has left for Egypt on a Government mission relative to the establishment of an Italian colony on the shores of the Red Sea.

This morning fires broke out almost simultaneously at various points of the city - one at Valde Tachemas near the spot where the great fire of the 5th of June last year commenced.

Bucharest, June 4. The Chamber was opened to-day by Prince Charles in person. His Royal Highness was received with great enthusiasm.

Toronto, June 6. Mr. Mackenzie, the leader of the Opposition in the Canadian House of Commons, delivered a speech strongly condemning the clauses of the Treaty concluded at Washington affecting Canada.

The New Brunswick Government has appointed a delegate to confer with the Government of Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island, with a view to an united action to oppose the Washington Treaty.

New York, June 6. There was a terrible storm at Galveston on Saturday and Sunday. A part of the city was submerged by the waters of the Gulf, and many buildings were destroyed.
